

## I. Event Date, Times, Location, Registration Fee, and General Information:

- Event: The Kentucky Cheer and Dance Classic
- Date: Saturday, February 16, 2019
- Time: 1:00, immediately following the Middle School State Cheer and Dance Classic
- Location: Woodford County Middle School Versailles, KY

Cancellation Fee: \$100.00 after February 12, 2019 for ALL teams and individuals,

no exceptions.

- Many "CHEER and DANCE" divisions with EVERYONE in mind: Individuals, School Teams, Youth Teams, and All-Star Teams.
- Any school without a dance team that is competing in the pom division will have the option of entering their cheerleading squad in the pom division of the dance portion of the competition.
- There will be multiple divisions for cheerleading squads based on squad size for those who compete with 2 ½ minute routines.
- There are also "Game Day" divisions for Junior High and High Schools.
- For dance teams, there will be four divisions based on style of dance.
- An individual may not compete on more than one squad/team of the same category.
- The main performance and the warm-up mat will be 42' x 54' (9 strips).
- All participants must submit a signed waiver form prior to performing. NO EXCEPTIONS.
- Video cameras and traditional cameras are permitted in the performance arena provided that they are hand held and photographers remain in their seats. No tripods are allowed.
- The Team Spirit Shop will be available the day of competition for all of your cheer and dance apparel and accessories.
- Spectator admission for ages 5 and up is \$10 per person. Children up to age four are admitted free.

  - Youth/Parks and Recreation Small: up to16 members, K-6th grade, multiple schools
  - Youth/Parks and Recreation Large: 17 plus members with no limit, K-6<sup>th</sup> grade, multiple schools
  - Elementary Small: up to 16 members, K-6<sup>th</sup> grade, single school
  - Elementary Large: 17 plus members with no limit, K-6<sup>th</sup> grade, single school
  - Junior High Small: up to 12 members, 4th through 8th grade
  - o Junior High Medium: 13-16 members, 4th through 8th grade
  - O Junior High Large: 17-20 members, 4th through 8th grade
  - Junior High Super Large: 21 plus members with no limit, 4<sup>th</sup> through 8<sup>th</sup> grade
  - Senior High Small: up to 12 members, 7<sup>th</sup> through 12<sup>th</sup> grade
  - o Senior High Medium: 13-16 members, 7<sup>th</sup> through 12<sup>th</sup> grade
  - Senior High Large: 17-20 members, 7<sup>th</sup> through 12<sup>th</sup> grade
  - o Senior High Super Large: 21 plus members with no limit, 7th through 12th grade
  - Senior High Coed: Any team with 3 or more males.
  - o Elementary School Dance: No limit, K-6th grade, single school
  - Junior High School Dance: No limit, 4<sup>th</sup> through 8<sup>th</sup> grade
  - Senior High School Dance: No limit, 7<sup>th</sup> through 12<sup>th</sup> grade
  - Allstar teams are based on the USASF age grid.
